Scope

We are looking for a musician/singer worship leader who has a passion for using music and worship to connect people with Christ in worship, has a devout prayer life, and has the leadership to oversee volunteer worship teams. They should be comfortable speaking in front of large groups of people.

The worship leader will lead a team to provide meaningful worship services. They will need to provide primary leadership for the modern worship team and secondary support for the traditional worship team.

The leader will ideally engage in other areas of ministry to support the life of the church with music.

It is important to note this position is more than a job. Worshiping God with all that we have is imperative, no matter the role. The position is part of setting a spiritual tone for the music in our congregation.

What will you do?

Lead the Modern worship team

Coordinate music with pastors for upcoming worship services

Schedule worship team to ensure positions are filled for events

Lead rehearsals

Recruit and train new volunteer musicians

Lead, support, encourage and help volunteers to grow in their skills, and to cast vision

Take ownership of the modern stage, setting it for services and coordinating its upkeep.

Maintain all sound equipment, supplies

Lead/Coordinate Special service, Christmas, Easter, Lenten services

Support music and creative endeavors in all areas of ministry
